009* ROYAL MARINES COMMAND FORMATION BADGES

3 Cdo Bde RM Formation Badge


1. CGRM has directed that a new formation insignia be introduced and worn on CS 95 by all personnel serving within 3 Commando Brigade RM.
2. The Badge will consist of a black fighting knife on a commando green square background. All members of the Brigade will be issued 5 badges for wearing on combat jackets and CS 95 shirts. All ranks should have removed the old insignia and sewn on the new formation insignia by 1 March 2002.
3. The new badge is only to be worn on the wearer's **right** arm in accordance with the diagram at Annex A. It is to be positioned centrally (with the knife's blade uppermost) on the right arm, 90mm from the shoulder seam to the top of the badge. In accordance with BR81, holders of Parachutist wings should position the badge 64mms from the shoulder seam to the centre of the parachutist badge.

Fleet Protection Group Royal Marines Formation Badge

4. CGRM has approved the procurement of a Group Badge to recognise FPGRM's unique role in fulfilling specialist security tasks throughout the UK. The badge will usefully acknowledge the important contribution made by the Unit's RN ranks, some of whom are not commando trained and provide ethos, identity and sense of belonging to the Unit. The introduction of this insignia is seen as a significant move that complements the Unit's change of name and relocation to Faslane within the last 12 months.
5. The FPGRM Badge will consist of a black fighting knife and the RN Crown on a commando green background as at Annex B. All FPGRM ranks are to have sewn on the new Formation Badge by 1 March 2002. The badge is to be worn as described for the 3 Cdo Bde RM Formation Badge; details at Annex A.
6. BR81 and RMIs will be amended in due course.

POSITIONING OF RMC FORMATION BADGES


Right Arm - Para
