Following the Conference on Drill which was held at Depot RM, Deal in May, 1946, RM Interpretations are being revised. RM Interpretations, 1946, will be issued shortly on a limited distribution. Subsequently, revised RM Interpretations will be issued in printed form as amendments to the Manuals; these will include all RM Interpretations in force.

- 2. No local rules at variance with the Manuals, as adjusted by RM Interpretations, are to be adopted. The greatest care is to be exercised to ensure that the Manuals are correctly and exactly followed.
- Battle Drill.

 Battle Drill, when taught, will be a drill for tactical training, and not part of parade instruction.
- 4. Time of Marching. Time of marching will be 120 paces to the minute, except during the first few weeks of training when it will be 130 paces to the minute.
- 5. Fixing and Unfixing Bayonets. Standard drills for fixing and unfixing bayonets at the halt and on the march will be issued. Fixing and unfixing bayonets on the march will not be taught unless specially required for display purposes.
- 6. Piling and Unpiling Arms. These movements will not be taught.
- 7. Guards of Honour.

 An amended procedure to replace that laid down in the Manual of Ceremonial, Section 77, will be issued.
- 8. Bugle and Drum Stick Drill. Detail will be re-issued.
