

145 EMBROIDERED MINIATURE BADGES OF RANK FOR SNCOs WHITE EVENING DRESS

With effect from the date of this Order the metal badges of rank and the Gold-on-Blue King's Badge, previously worn by SNCOs in White Evening Dress, are to be replaced by miniature Gold-on-Scarlet badges. The design and size of the badges concerned should conform to specimens submitted by RM Barracks, Eastney and held by the Commandant General.

2. Requirements for badges should be co-ordinated within units by an officer nominated by the Commanding Officer (preferably the officer responsible for clothing). They should be submitted, together with a cheque or postal order to cover the total cost, to the Supply Officer (Clothing), RM Barracks, Eastney who will arrange supply. Cheques, etc., should be made payable to the Cashier, RM Barracks, Eastney.

4. The method of affixing the badges to the jacket is left to individual choice. It must, however, be neat, and not visible externally. The position of the badge on the dress remains unaltered.
