

385 SPECIALIST QUALIFICATION—MARINE PROVOST

1. With the formation of a Brigade Provost Section it has been decided to introduce the Specialist Qualification of Marine Provost (MP) within the GD Branch of the Corps.

2. It will have a two tier structure; MP 1 and MP 2. The classification will be as follows :—

MP 2

a. To reach a satisfactory standard in :—

- (1) Voice procedure.
- (2) Driving a $\frac{1}{2}$ -ton vehicle.
- (3) Riding a motor cycle.

b. To pass the qualifying course held at The Depot and Training Establishment, Royal Military Police.

MP 1 As for MP 2 and in addition :—

- a. To perform satisfactorily the duties of MP 2 for a minimum period of 12 months.
- b. To be capable of performing satisfactorily the duties of NCO i/c Provost Section.
- c. To be recommended by his Commanding Officer.

3. The Commanding Officer, Royal Marines Barracks, Eastney may award the specialist qualification to ranks who gain the necessary qualifications. Commanding Officers of units will be responsible for advancing ranks to MP 1 when they become qualified. These awards are to be reported in Part II Orders.

4. The details shown at the Annex to this order are to be incorporated in RMI Appendix 6/8 Parts I and II.
