042* RE-DESIGNATION OF THE COMMANDO HELICOPTER OPERATIONS AND SUPPORT CELL (CHOSC) AS HEADQUARTERS COMMANDO AVIATION

1. In September 1995 front-line Commando Aviation strength at RNAS Yeovilton will be increased following amalgamation of 772 Naval Air Squadron into 845, 846 and 848 Naval Air Squadrons. On 1 September 1995, 3 Cdo Bde Air Sqn RM will be incorporated into the Naval Air Command and re-designated 847 Naval Air Squadron.

2. In order to reflect the increased responsibilities of the current Operations and Support Cell for the Commando Squadrons, the Commando Helicopter Operations and Support Cell (CHOSC) will be re-named 'Headquarters Commando Aviation'. This change will be effective from 1 September 1995.
