048\* ROYAL MARINES' UNIFORM FOR ROYAL GARDEN PARTIES

1. Recently there has been some confusion as to the correct uniform to be worn at Royal Garden Parties particularly when local Royal Navy instructions have ordered that No 1c should be worn. For Royal Marines 1c is Lovats which are not appropriate for such an event.

2. Notwithstanding any special instructions by the Palace on the invitation, No 1a (modified) should be worn (No 1a is blues). The modifications are as follows:
  - a. All officers - No 1a (negative sword, medals and gloves), peaked cap, Sam Browne, slacks and OP boots.
  - b. For WOs - No 1a (negative sword, medals and gloves), peaked cap, red sash, sword belt and shoes.
  - c. For SNCOs - No 1a (negative medals and gloves), peaked cap, red sash, white belt and shoes.
  - d. For Cpls and Mnes - No 1a (negative medals and gloves), peaked cap, white belt and shoes.
