1. Combined Operations Personnel - Badge.

18th April 1946

With reference to A.F.O. 4366/42 and R.M. Circular No. 5070/42.Q. dated 25th February, 1943, only the following are entitled to wear the Combined Operations Badge:-

- All ranks of Units of S.S.Group on completion of training.
- All ranks borne on the books of H.M.S.COPRA on completion of training.

2. The badge will be worn on both arms of the khaki battle-dress blouse and blue serge tunic, immediately below the woven arm badges "Royal Marines" and "Commando". In the case of the battle dress- blouse and 1-inch below the point of the shoulder in the case of the serge tunic.

3. In cases where the badge cannot be worn on both arms (e.g. King's badgemen and Instructors) it will be worn on the one arm.

4. R.M.Circular No.5070/42.Q. dated 25th February, 1943 is cancelled.
