

1. The Commandant General's Shooting Badge is awarded for exceptional prowess in rifle shooting at the representational level with the Royal Marines and for the application, dedication and discipline required to reach that level.
2. Authority to wear the badge will be promulgated in RMROs.

3. Eligibility to wear the badge is limited to those ranks currently serving who have shot as a member of the Royal Marines Eight, in the United Services Cup at the National Rifle Association annual meeting at Bisley.
