

84 STANDARDISATION IN SIZE OF LETTERS RM

1. At its eighth meeting, the Royal Marines Dress Committee directed that:

a. All letters RM should be standardised at $\frac{1}{2}$ inch width.

b. New entries should be issued with standard size anodised letters with effect from 1st April, 1966.

c. Men now serving would provide themselves with standard size anodised letters by 1st April, 1966.

2. Limited supplies of the standard size anodised letters RM are now available and may be demanded from Victualling Yards.

3. In the interim period the lack of uniformity of letters RM is to be accepted.

4. Dress Regulations will be amended.
