

9 POSITION OF CHEVRONS, SQ AND OTHER BADGES ON UNIFORM

1959

The position of chevrons and badges on Royal Marines other ranks uniform is covered generally in the Appendix to the Navy List under "Uniform Regulations for Royal Marines Other Ranks" Section III.

2 For certain badges the detail requires amplification, which is as follows:—

Tradesmans Badge	}	Central on right arm. Top of badge to be 6" from shoulder seam.

Musicians Badge		

*King's Badge Centrally on left arm. Top of badge to be 2" from shoulder seam. In khaki battledress, to allow for the wearing of the wider RM Commando shoulder flash, it is to be 3".

*Parachute Badge As for King's Badge except it is to be worn on right arm.

Section Leaders	}	Centrally on left arm, top of badge 2" down from shoulder seam.

*When the King's or Parachute Badges are worn by ranks in Commando Units, the formation sign on that shoulder will not be worn.
