- 2. I have spoken to RMSM (Lt Hoskins) about this subject to get a more detailed picture of what they require.
- 3. In the 19th Century, when there was a number of WOts in the Band Service they were an elaborate gold braided uniform. Col Neville, however, does not want the expense of reintroducing such an elaborate uniform for a WOI when it may only be worn infrequently.
- 4. What is envisinged is a normal band uniform (the material in the same in the band service for officers and musicians alike) with a scarlet sesh, sword and gold knot with the possible addition of some extra gold braid on the tunio's collar.
- 5. Certain guildlines can be obtained from Article 0622 of BR 81 which deals with RSMs uniforms and, with the exception of the gold braid, would support RMSM's ideas. These are:
  - a. The material for an RSM's uniform is the same as an officers (In the case of the band this is so).
  - b. A RSM wears a Sam Browne and sword identical to officers (the RMSM want the WO1 to have scarlet sash and sword with gold knot as worn by Band Officers.
  - c. The helmet badge would be the same as that of an officer (RMSM have not mentioned this point but it would be in line with 0622 c).
- 6. Quite obviously there will need to be more discussion on this subject but the above gives a broad picture of what is required.
