3. PRODUCT DESIGN This specification defines the requirements for textile badges, titles and other distinguishing items, and for the threads, yarns and other components used in their construction.

TABLE 4 – PRODUCT COMPONENTS

<p>4.1 Threads and yarns</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The thread or yarn is to be of uniform thickness and is to be spun and folded evenly. • The shades and compositions of all the coloured threads or yarns are to match those of the respective Standard Pattern unless otherwise specified by the tender or contract. They are to be uniform throughout the length and thickness and are to satisfy the colour fastness requirements of Table 6. • The threads or yarns are to be reasonably free from knots, short lengths and other defects.
<p>4.2 Ground cloth</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For badges manufactured from melton ground cloth, the cloth is to be light melton as specified in UK/SC/5516. • For badges manufactured from polyester cotton ground cloth, the cloth is to be as specified in UK/SC/6576. • For woven badges see standard pattern. • Colour of ground cloth is to be as standard pattern. • For all khaki badges pattern number: MAT0024A. Fabric requirements to table 7 and 8.
<p>4.3 Backing</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Dark coloured backing cloths.</u> Cloth, plain weave flax, black, Ref No. WS1 to BS 4973: Part 4, Pattern No. 8443A. NATO Stock No. 8305-99-942-7523 • <u>Medium to light coloured backing cloths.</u> Cloth, plain weave flax, to meet the physical requirements of BS 4973: Part 4 but to match shade of standard pattern. • Or an alternative approved by DC.
<p>4.4 Adhesive</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The adhesive used is to affix the backing firmly and must not discolour the embroidery when the badges, titles and other items are subjected to the tests in Table 6 or in use.

<p>5.1 Devices</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The devices on the badges, titles and other items, whether hand or machine manufactured, are to be in strict accordance with the respective Standard Pattern. • Hand embroidered badges – it is important that variants between hand embroiders is minimal. • Machine embroidered badges – variations in the stitch counts from the standard pattern should not show any significant visual difference from the relevant standard pattern. • Woven badges – variations in the weave from the standard pattern should not show any significant visual difference from the relevant standard pattern. • Chevrons appliqué – the weave of the lace should match the relevant standard pattern and be stitch applied to the backing cloth with not less than 4 stitches per cm. Mitres and lace end under folds should be neat, straight and all raw edges should be hidden.
<p>5.2 Form</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ground cloths and backings, where required, are to be cut to the same size and shape as the respective Standard Pattern.
<p>5.3 Conformity</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All items are to be in strict conformity with the respective Standard Pattern in design, shade and appearance.
<p>5.4 Components</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All components are to be as Standard Pattern unless suitable alternatives have been agreed.
<p>5.5 Finish and Appearance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The dyes used for the embroidery and other yarns or materials are to produce the same colour, shade and appearance as in the respective Standard Pattern and are to satisfy the tests for fastness specified in Table 6.
